What is Family Reconnect?

Family Reconnect staff work with youth both in shelter and around Waterloo Region as a prevention and diversion program. The Family Reconnect staff offer support and advocacy for youth and those they consider family, to establish and maintain healthy and supportive relationships.

Whether the goal is to return to the family home or live independently, our Family Reconnect team provides family mediation and support in navigating family breakdown and conflict, improving communication skills, goal setting and creating space for youth to establish a safety net of support to utilize throughout their life.

Did You Know?

The biggest driver of youth homelessness is breakdown of the family.

How It Works

What To Expect

The Family Reconnect Program can provide varying supports for youth and their families, including:

- CASE MANAGEMENT
- FAMILY MEDIATION
- ADVOCACY
- HELP REACHING HOUSING GOALS
- MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE SUPPORT
- REFERRALS TO OTHER COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Who Can Access Family Reconnect?

Youth in the Waterloo Region at risk of, or experiencing homelessness aged 12-25. Youth and their families can be referred to the program by any organization or self-refer. Family Reconnect youth may also access other services, including:
